Frames

Our frames are made of wood and come in three virationas: oiled Danish oak, fumed Danish oak & painted poppel wood.

Seats & tops

Our seats and tops are made of painted plywood and come in two variations: glossy finish (gloss 70-90) or matte finish (silky matte gloss 30).

Sustainable production

All editions of a seat in Siena are made in Denmark and produced from FSC certified cut off wood from large scale Danish productions.

Product character

Wood is an organic material that evolves over time. Daily use adds to the unique character and patina. Because a seat in Siena is produced from cut off wood, they sometimes come with beauty marks. These can for example be a small knob or a slight difference to be traced in the wood's vein structure.

Product warranty

We ensure a 2 year warranty after the date of purchase. The warranty does not apply in cases of improper use, wear and tear or lack of maintenance.

Cleaning & care

The seat is very easy to clean with a damp cloth. Once in a while we recommend that you sand down the frame using 180 grit sanding paper and after apply one of our carefully developed oils from our Wood care line.

As any other painted product the surface of our glossy seats can be scratched if exposed for heavy use or direct contact with sharp items.
